Our story began in 2013 when the organisation was established by Tony and Jonny luso in the Northern Rivers region of New South Wales. Driven by their passion and dedication, Tony and Jonny's vision centred around the provision of personalised and accessible services that focus on people. The organisation became a vehicle for accessing the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) and My Aged Care services.

Tony and Jonny's connection to the disability and community sectors stems much deeper than their more than 30 years of professional experience. It embodies their life work and the memory of their daughter, Emily. Born in 1992 with major health complications and diagnosed with a disability, Emily tragically passed away in 1996 leaving a legacy that both Tony and Jonny feel is their vocation.

Today Jonny is Managing Director and Liam (Tony and Jonny's son) has joined the ranks as a support worker.

#### Rules & FYI

All games will be played as per the official Netball Rule Book

No gloves are permitted

No hard brimmed hats/caps to be worn

Fingernails must be short and smooth

No adomment jewellery may be worn, a wedding ring must be taped

Medical Alert bracelet is to be covered with tape

Players are not permitted to wear any item that could endanger themselves or others

All injuries are to be reported to the netball control table. St John's Ambulance will be in attendance for the 3 days of competition. .

No alcohol/smoking/vaping near/around the court area Glass containers

No dogs are allowed on or within 3 metres of the court surface area, whenever courts are in use. This includes competitions, carnivals, gala days and training. This does not apply to companion dogs.

Sunshades can be set up on the grassed area around the courts but please secure them for safety. We cannot store sunshades as previously.

Please dispose of any rubbish in the bins provided.

Parking on the grassed area of Diadem Street.

It would be greatly appreciated if all local teams competing could help with the pole padding and bins each morning and afternoon.

#### Food

Without a clubhouse we are struggling to provide a canteen. We only have 1 power outlet available and for us to provide what we usually have for players is impossible this year.

The **30's** division (9 teams) will play each other once over the 2 days (8 games + bye) then split into 2 pools (A & B) for the semi-finals on Sunday. The point score will determine which pool.

The team that finishes on the bottom of the point score will not take part in the semifinals.

The division that has been combined, 35's (3 teams), 40's (3 teams) & 30's (4 teams pool C) will play each other on Friday and Saturday. Points will only be recorded when a team in the same division play each other.

**35's** the teams that finish in position 1 & 2 will play a semifinal and the team in position 3 going through to the final.

**40's** the teams that finish in position 1 & 2 will play a semifinal and the team in position 3 going through to the final.

30's C all teams will play a semifinal.

Score cards will be on the court for the start of each day. Please leave the score cards and clipboard on the court after your game. The winning team to return the score card to control. Please have a scorer from each team sitting together to score.

Games will consist of 2 x 12 minutes halves, with a 2 minute break at half time and 4 minutes between rounds

A player may only play in her registered age division.

Please forward the draw to your umpire for her duties.
